WHEREAS: Article VIII of the Associated Students of Colorado State University Constitution mandates that the Senate approve any funding request to the ASCSU Student Funding Board over \$10,000; and,

WHEREAS: The request from the American Indian Science and Engineering Society (AISES) for the Native American Month Kickoff and the 29th Annual Pow Wow is over the \$10,000 limit; and,

WHEREAS: The application received a score of 87.75% from the Student Funding Board. 79.01% of more is required for full funding of the application. Therefore, it was awarded at the full request.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ENACTED

That \$18,626.00 be allocated to AISES for their “Native American Month Kickoff and 29th Annual Pow Wow” from the Student Funding Board account to be spent in accordance with the attached budget as amended and in accordance with Student Funding Board and ASCSU guidelines.
