Amending the Deadlines for Legislation and Guest Speakers**

WHEREAS: Currently, as defined by Article IV, Section C of the Bylaws for the Forty-First Senate, all legislation must be submitted “by 5:00 p.m. on the Monday before its first reading” in order to be included on the Senate agenda; and,

WHEREAS: Refining bills and resolutions often entails requesting additional information or documents from the author; and,

WHEREAS: Moving such a deadline to the week prior would enable the Senate officers to adequately make all necessary changes; and,

WHEREAS: Such an action would help the Senate officers draft a complete Senate agenda with ample time.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED

That Article III, Section E of the Bylaws of the Forty-First Senate be amended to read as follows:

“Guest speakers shall be submitted to the Speaker of the Senate by 5:00 p.m. ~~Monday~~ **Friday** for inclusion in the next Senate agenda.”; and,

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED

That Article IV, Section C of the Bylaws of the Forty-First Senate be amended to read as follows:

“Bills and resolutions shall be in procedural form and submitted to the Parliamentarian, Speaker Pro Tempore, and the Speaker of the Senate by 5:00 p.m. on the ~~Monday~~ **Friday** before its first reading to ensure that all grammatical errors are corrected. Any legislation not following this process may be deemed by the Speaker as out of order and not added to the agenda.”
